Safety data sheet for rosin

Product: Rosin (violin resin)

Uses: Rosin is mainly used for string instruments to hold the bow hairs, as well as in the electronics and paint industries.

Materials: Rosin is made from natural resins obtained from pine, spruce and fir trees.

Risks:

Allergic reactions: May cause allergic skin reactions (H317).

Irritation: May irritate skin and respiratory tract.

Fire Hazard: May ignite upon contact with flames or electrostatic discharge.

Security measures:

Handling: Wear protective gloves and avoid contact with skin.

Use: Use rosin only in well-ventilated areas.

Storage: Store rosin in a dry, cool place away from sources of ignition.

Storage Notes: Store rosin in a dry, safe place, away from moisture and extreme temperatures.

First aid measures:

Skin contact: In case of skin contact, clean the affected area thoroughly with soap and water
