Safety Data Sheet for Tools

Use: Tools are used for various craft activities, repairs, construction work and assembly work.

Materials: Tools are typically made of metal (e.g. steel, aluminum), plastic, wood, or a combination of these materials.

Risks:

Risk of injury: Sharp edges, moving parts or pointed ends can lead to cuts, punctures or crushing injuries.

Risk of breakage: Improper handling or excessive loading can result in breakage and injury.

Electrical hazard: Electric tools pose a risk of electric shock if handled improperly.

Allergic Reactions: Some materials may cause allergic reactions.

Security measures:

Handling: Use tools only for their intended purpose and handle them carefully.

Protective Equipment: Wear appropriate protective equipment such as gloves, safety glasses and hearing protection to avoid injury.

Maintenance: Check tools regularly for wear or damage and perform maintenance if necessary.

Storage: Store tools in a safe place, out of the reach of children and away from moisture.

Electrical Safety: Make sure electrical tools are properly grounded and the power source is connected correctly.

First aid measures:

Electrical injuries: Immediately unplug the electrical tool from the power source and seek medical attention.
