Safety data sheet for music stand lights

Product: music stand lights

Usage: Music stand lights are used to illuminate sheet music and other documents on music stands. They are often used by musicians during performances and rehearsals.

Materials:

Housing: metal (e.g. aluminum), plastic

Light source: LEDs or incandescent lamps

Cable: copper wire, plastic insulation (e.g. PVC, TPE)

Risks:

Electrical hazard: Risk of electric shock from damaged or defective lights and cables.

Risk of injury: Sharp edges or broken parts can lead to cuts.

Fire hazard: Overheating or short circuit can lead to fire.

Eye damage: Staring directly into the bulbs can cause eye damage.

Security measures:

Handling: Use the music stand lights only according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Use: Check lights and cables regularly for wear or damage and replace defective parts.

Storage: Store products in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

Electrical Safety: Make sure lights are properly connected and there are no loose connections.

Eye Protection: Avoid staring directly at the bulbs.

First aid measures:

Electric shock: Immediately disconnect the device from the power source and seek medical attention.

Cuts: Clean the wound thoroughly and apply a sterile compress.

Burn injuries: Cool the affected area and seek medical attention if necessary.

Eye injuries: If your eyes are damaged by strong light, seek medical attention immediately.
